Long spiked water smartweed or Persicaria (*Polygonum coccineum*)

Wild cucumber vine (*Echinocystis lobata*)

Jewelweed (*Impatiens biflora*)

Broad-leaved water plantain (*Alisma plantago-aquatica*)

Arum-leaved arrowhead or Duck potato (*Sagittaria cuneata*)

Hedge Bindweed(*Convolvulus sepium*)

Green Ridge Trail:

Dotted blazing star (*Liatris punctata*)

Joe Pye Weed (*Eupatorium maculatum*) by another concrete box bridge built in 1917 by Frank Esterby.
